The Swiss 2226 JED receives the AGPB Award 2025

No temperature below 22 or above 26 degrees Celsius all year round, without much technology.

The office building in Schlieren shows how it can be done: resource-saving architecture and low-tech building control “made in Austria” enable the so-called 22-26 principle, being largely energy self-sufficient. This deserves the Austrian Green Planet Building® (AGPB) Award!

With 18,300 m², the JED (“Join, Explore, Dare”) is the largest building designed according to the principle invented by Professor Dietmar Eberle. baumschlager eberle architekten focused primarily on the construction method and a suitable operating system: a low-mass building and good insulation minimize heating and cooling requirements, deep window reveals allow natural shading, and automated ventilation flaps equipped with CO₂ and temperature sensors ensure fresh air and temperature control. 8,300 m³ of Zirkulit concrete was used in the construction: a recycled concrete that can be reused. Together with the high flexibility of use due to the large spans, one can only say: this is how circular economy works in buildings!

The Austrian Green Planet Building® (AGPB) Award focuses on energy efficiency and the supply of renewable energy. This transfers the objectives and criteria of the national climate protection initiative klimaaktiv for the construction and property industry to an international environment. AGPB honours the outstanding achievements of Austrian planning offices, consultants, construction companies and production companies abroad in the field of sustainable building.

AGPB is an initiative of the Austrian Federal Ministry for Innovation, Mobility and Infrastructure (BMIMI), the Austrian Federal Ministry for Economy, Energy and Tourism (BMWET), and ADVANTAGE AUSTRIA.
